An Opinion and Order was adopted in #82-13, Alton Water Co., by a vote of 5-0, Mr. Dumelle concurred.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #82-75, German Valley, by a vote of 5-0.

A Proposed Order, Second Notice and Proposed Opinion were adopted in R77-12, Water Pollution, (Docket D) Effluent Disinfection, by a vote of 4-1. Mr. Dumelle dissented and will file a dissenting opinion.

A Proposed Order for First Notice was adopted in R80-22, SO₂, by a vote of 5-0, Mr. Dumelle concurred.

In #79-112, Modine, petitioner's motion for additional time was denied and the case was dismissed by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson concurred. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

In # 79-209, Mobil, motion to strike was denied, respondent was granted to September 1 to respond to petitioner's brief and the petitioner was given leave to reply by September 11. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

In #80-125, Welin, a motion to vacate and rehearing was denied in part. Rehearing on a specific issue only was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

The Board granted reconsideration of its' June 10, 1982 Order in the matter of #81-143, Wheeler, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Since an objection was filed in #82-9, Arvey, a hearing was authorized by a vote of 5-0.

In # 82-76, Equity Associates, motion for expedited consideration was granted and the matter was scheduled for decision on September 2, 1982, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

These matters were discussed and held to September 2, 1982 for further discussion or possible decision: ## 81-177, A.S. Hansen; 81-203, Amax Coal; 81-61, Bunge Corp.; R81-12, Sauget/E. St. Louis; R81-28, PWS Amendments; R81-30, Trade Secrets.

#81-98, Wasteland was discussed.

The Board decided to hold a special meeting on August 26, 1982

at 11:00 A.M. to consider # 81-98, Wasteland and to consider R80-22, SO₂, Proposed Opinion. The Clerk was asked to post required notices.

In new cases these actions were taken by a vote of 5-0: ##82-90, Drelicharz v. O'Hare Water Reclamation Plant, hearing authorized; 82-92, Causey v. Centralia, dismissed, to be referred to IEPA as an informal complaint, Order by Mr. Goodman; 82-96 and 82-97, held to September 2, for consideration; 82-98, Centralia, held for an Agency recommendation; 82-99, Illinois Dept. of Transportation, Abbott Labs; Chairman authorized to sign, Order by Mr. Dumelle; 82-100, Conoco, hearing authorized; 82-101, Browning-Ferris v. Lake County Board, hearing authorized and an Order adopted on procedures, Order by Mrs. Anderson.

Dockets were opened in these matters by Orders prepared by Mr. Anderson: R82-18, Amendments to Phase I, RCRA Rules and R82-19, Phase II RCRA Rules. The Orders were adopted by a vote of 5-0.

R82-20, Grain Handling Amendments, was authorized for hearing and publication by a vote of 5-0.

All other matters not disposed of as listed were ordered placed on an agenda for possible consideration on September 2, 1982.

The Chairman announced that Mr. William L. Staehle, Administrator of the Illinois-Indiana Bi-State Commission would be addressing the Board at 2:00 P.M.
