MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
September 15, 1982 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0: ## 81-136, Willutzki v. Lombard; 81-180, Allen; 81-182, Capital City Land et al., Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Anderson concurred; 82-40, Radar; 82-86, Delavan; 82-89, Downtown Lombard.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #82-19, McHenry by a vote of 4-1, Mrs. Anderson dissented.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #82-47, Lambert v. Saline, by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Anderson dissented.

R81-15, Rowe Foundry, was dismissed by a vote of 5-0.

The Board then decided to reconsider the decision to request an Opinion from the Illinois Attorney General on the power of sub-delegation with regard to R82-11, Parallel Shore Protection. The decision, which was made at the September 2, 1982 meeting was then withdrawn by a vote of 5-0.

A Proposed Rule, First Notice was then adopted in R82-11, Parallel Shore Protection by a vote of 5-0.

Motion to vacate and reconsider was denied in #79-142, Citizens Utilities, by a vote of 5-0 and the Order of September 2, 1982 was reaffirmed. Mrs Anderson will prepare the Order.

Since the remand in #80-153, Hamman was issued the Board adopted an Order, ordering the IEPA to issue a permit. The vote was 5-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare the Order.

Request for Order in #81-85, Gilt Edge, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to stay in #82-55, Waste Management, was denied by a vote of 3-0. Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Werner abstained. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Joint stipulation and motion to stay in #82-69, Hanover Park, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted on #82-68, Trade Waste, ordering that it be set for hearing by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.
