MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
October 14, 1982 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0:
##81-179, Nauvoo Milk Products; 81-187, Norris City Sanitary District; 82-23, Trojan (Opinion only); 82-65, John Prior; 82-68, Trade Waste (Order only).

A Proposed Rule, First Notice in R78-15, Rochelle, was adopted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Werner concurred.

Motion for leave to file motion for reconsideration in #78-233, Granite City, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Joint motion for stay and dismissal in #79-87, Sauget, was denied and the parties were given 45 days to file a status report. The vote was 5-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #80-153, Hamman, regarding a motion to modify by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #81-98, Wasteland, regarding a motion to modify by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Werner abstained. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

In #81-134, Donovan, the petitioner was ordered to submit the transcript of the hearing within 15 days or be subject to dismissal. The vote was 4-1, Mr. Goodman dissented. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Order.

#81-171, Getty, was ordered to a second hearing by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #82-119, Waste Management, on a motion for clarification by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

In R80-5, RACT II, an Order was adopted amending the Second Notice Order by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.


