MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
October 27, 1982 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0: ##82-2, Engineered Coated Products; 82-88, BFGoodrich, Mr. Werner concurred; 82-93, Georgia-Pacific; 82-98, City of Centralia.

R81-24, Olin, was discussed and held to November 12 for consideration.

Application for nondisclosure in ##75-80, -141, U.S. Steel, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Request for extension of time to file a report in #80-38, Bacon's Farm, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw in #80-231, American Hoescht, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion for protective order and motion to substitute attorney were granted in #82-16, Steel v. Beucher. Other discovery requests were referred to the Hearing officer. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

In #82-31, Motor Oils, motion to withdraw was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

In #82-119, Waste Management, motion to strike and motion to reconsider were denied by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

R81-29, Pfizer was discussed and held over for further consideration at a later date.
