MAY 16, 1985 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

All Board Members were present save Mr. Nega.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #84-123, Village of Energy, by a vote of 6-0.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #84-157, American Can, by a vote of 5-1. Mr. Forcade dissented.

An Order was adopted in #84-56, McHenry County Landfill, by a vote of 5-1. Mr. Meyer dissented.

A Proposed Rule, Second First Notice Order was adopted in R82-1, Particulate Emission Limitations, by a vote of 6-0.

A Proposed Rule, First Notice, Proposed Opinion and order was adopted in R82-7, Petition for Site-Specific Relief by the City of Alton, by a vote of 6-0.

Motion for extension of time to file Recommendation was granted in #84-174 (Docket B), Classic Finishing, by a vote of 5-1; Mr. Dumelle dissented. Mr. Meyer will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw was granted in #85-8, Signode Supply, by a vote of 6-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.


