MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
May 26, 1977 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted by a vote of 5-0 in these cases: ##75-317, Sexton; 76-181, Decatur Sanitary District, Mr. Dumelle Concurred; 77-2, CIPS; 77-78, Evergreen, Mr. Dumelle will file a supplemental statement; 77-67, Dunlap; 77-65, Larrabee, Mr. Dumelle will file a supplemental statement; 77-80, CPC; 77-98, Grayslake; 77-97, Cook Construction (Interim Order); 77-96, Gibson (Interim Order); 75-480, U.S. Tobacco.

Opinions and Orders were adopted by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Young dissented, in these cases: ##76-324, Fairfield; 77-35, Gilman; R74-10, Motor Vehicle Noise (Opinion only).

An amended petition was accepted in #75-106, Electric Energy and held for an Agency recommendation by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Zeitlin will prepare the Order.

Motion to vacate H.O. Order was granted in #76-242, Interlake by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted on a motion to withdraw in #76-294, Elgin v. Waste Mgt. by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Zeitlin will prepare the Order. The motion was held pending response to the Order.

Request to decide without hearing in #77-22, Mobil Oil was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Young will prepare the Order.

Motion to amend was granted in #77-60, Commans by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Order.

Motion to withdraw objection in #77-83, Waterman was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Order.

Motion to decide without hearing was granted in #77-93, Ohio Power and the amended petition was ordered held for an Agency recommendation by a vote of 5-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

Motion to reconsider in #77-113, Puklin v. Swanson was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Zeitlin will prepare the Order.

Motion for extension of time in ##74-475 and 75-35, General Motors was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Zeitlin will prepare the Order.

Motion to continue in #77-69, Kaufman was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Zeitlin will prepare the Order.

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Request to extend time for briefs in R75-9 et al, Carbon Monoxide was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Zeitlin will prepare the Order.

Motion to continue pending R74-15,-16 was granted for #77-90, Shell Oil by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Zeitlin will prepare the Order.

Ossami Lake Homeowners Assoc., hearing mandatory; 77-139, held to June 9; 77-140, Harry Weese & Assoc, additional information requested, vote was 4-0, Mr. Dumelle abstained.

A proposed amendment to the WQS filed by the Agency on May 10, 1977 was given the number R77-12, and authorized for hearing and publication by a vote of 5-0.
