MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING NOVEMBER 20, 1997 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS - 10:30 A.M.

After calling the meeting to order, Chairman Manning welcomed members of the public and staff to the meeting. Thereafter, the Clerk was asked for a roll call, and all Board Members answered present.

Minutes of the November 6, 1997 Board Meeting, were approved by a vote of 7-0.

In R97-13, Emissions Reduction Market System Adoption of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 205, an Adopted Rule, Final Order, Opinion and Order, was adopted by a vote of 7-0. **(KMH)(McF)(JY)**

In R97-20, RCRA Subtitle D Update, USEPA Regulations (July 1, 1996 through December 31, 1996), an Adopted Rule, Final Order, Opinion and Order, was adopted by a vote of 7-0. **(GTG)**

In R98-8, Clean Fuel Fleet Program: Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 241, an Adopted Rule, Final Order, Opinion and Order, was adopted by a vote of 7-0. **(JY)**

In R98-13, Amendments to General Permitting Provisions to Require Perpetual Permits for Certain Sources: Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 201, a Proposed Rule, First Notice, Opinion and Order, was adopted by a vote of 6-1. Board Member J. Theodore Meyer dissented. **(McF)**

Petitioner's memorandum in response to an October 2, 1997 Board Order, will be taken with the case-in-chief in AS 96-6, Petition of Amoco Oil Company for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 721.132.

An Opinion and Order, was adopted in #97-111, People of the State of Illinois v. John Prior and Industrial Salvage, Inc., by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. **(GTG)**

An Order granting the complainant's agreed motion to dismiss, and closing the docket, was adopted in #AC 97-55, County of Will v. Phyllis Harrington and Phillip Sandberg, Jr., by a vote of 7-0. **(JTM)**

A Default Order finding that the respondent violated Sections 21(p)(1) and (p)(3) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, and assessing a \$1,000.00 penalty, was adopted in #AC 98-11, County of Will v. Kavanaugh Enterprises, Inc., by a vote of 7-0. **(CAM)**

This Administrative Citation was accepted by the Board: #98-14, Montgomery County v. Envotech-Illinois, Inc.

An Order granting the petitioner's motion to withdraw the appeal, and closing the docket, was adopted in #91-219, General Motors Corporation, Powertrain Division v. IEPA, by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. **(CAM)**

An Order granting the petitioner's motion to dismiss, and closing the docket, was adopted in #94-199, Citizens Utilities Company of Illinois v. IEPA, by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. **(GTG)**

An Order granting in part and denying in part, complainant's motion for partial summary judgment, accepting respondent's counterclaim for hearing, and denying complainant's motion to lift stay as moot, was adopted in #96-180, Environmental Site Developers, Inc. v. White & Brewer Trucking, Inc., by a vote of 4-2. Board Members G. Tanner Girard and J. Theodore Meyer dissented, and Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. **(McF)**

An Order denying the complainant's motion for partial summary judgment, and finding that inasmuch as the pleadings themselves establish that there exist issues of material fact, the subsidiary issue of whether the affidavits attached to the complainant's motion are sufficient to support the motion for summary judgment was moot, was adopted in #96-209, People of the State of Illinois v. Macon County Landfill Corporation, by a vote of 6-0. Chairman C.A. Manning abstained. **(RCF)**

An Order directing the Clerk of the Board to cause publication of the required newspaper notice of a motion to request relief from the hearing requirement, was adopted in #96-229, People of the State of Illinois v. James Tull, individually, and as President of CEPCO, Inc., and CEPCO, Inc., d/b/a Chief Paving & Excavating Company, by a vote of 7-0. **(JTM)**

An Order granting the complainant's motion to voluntarily dismiss the matter with prejudice, and closing the docket, was adopted in #96-265, Edward M. Pearl v. Bicoastal Corporation, Singer Corporation, and Eaton Corporation, by a vote of 7-0. **(JY)**

An Order granting the respondent's motion to dismiss, was adopted in #97-84, George Casanave v. Amoco Oil Company, by a vote of 7-0. Board Member R.C. Flemal concurred. **(CAM)**

An Order granting the petitioner's motion to withdraw those portions of its petition for review regarding scales, scale buildings or scalehouses, leaving at issue in its appeal only petitioner's request that the Agency delete special condition #4 from its permit, was adopted in #97-104, Continental Waste Industries of Illinois, Inc. v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. **(KMH)**

An Order denying the petitioner's request for oral argument, was adopted in #97-156, Village of Fox River Grove v. IEPA, by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. **(GTG)**

An Order dismissing the docket as unnecessary due to the petitioner's failure to file an appeal on or before October 15, 1997, was adopted in #98-33, East Saint Louis Housing Authority v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. (CAM)

An Order dismissing the docket as unnecessary due to the petitioner's failure to file an appeal on or before October 30, 1997, was adopted in #98-35, Sycamore Community Unit School District No. 427 v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. (CAM)

An Order dismissing the docket as unnecessary due to the petitioner's failure to file an appeal on or before November 10, 1997, was adopted in #98-39, W.E.S. Enterprises, Inc. v. IEPA, by a vote 7-0. (CAM)

An Order directing the Clerk of the Board to cause publication of the required newspaper notice of a motion to request relief from the hearing requirement, was adopted in #98-42, People of the State of Illinois v. Illini Protein, by a vote of 7-0. (GTG)

A provisional variance was granted in #98-68, Fedders Corporation v. IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. (CAM)

IEPA, by a vote of 7-0. (CAM)

An Order directing the petitioner to file an amended petition, was adopted in #98-72, St. Clair Properties Development, Inc. v. IEPA, by a vote of 6-0. Board Member K.M. Hennessey abstained. (CAM)



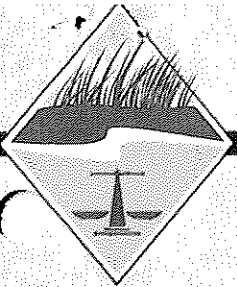

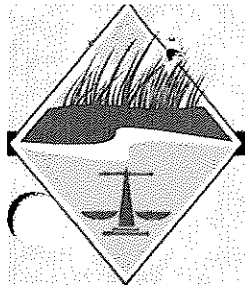
