MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
SEPTEMBER 17, 1987 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

All Board Members were present.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #86-6, City of Wood River CSO, by a vote of 6-0. (JD)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #AC87-6, James Pressnall, by a vote of 5-1. B. Forcade dissented. (JM)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #87-35, Village of Minooka, by a vote of 4-2. Messrs. J. Dumelle and B. Forcade dissented. (JA)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #87-38, Dept. of the Army, by a vote of 6-0. J. Dumelle concurred. (JM)

A Proposal for Public Comment, Proposed Opinion and Order, were adopted in R87-29, UIC Update (January 1, 1987 through June 30, 1987), by a vote of 6-0. (JA)

Orders were adopted in these Administrative Citations by a vote of 6-0: ##87-75, Loren Dowty; 87-80, Anton Rupe; 87-81, Central Illinois Disposal Company; 87-82, Alorton/Summrall.

Board Member B. Forcade moved a draft Order in #83-132, Dunn Company. Motion to amend by J. Anderson failed to carry by a 3-3 vote with J. Anderson, J. Dumelle and J. Marlin for it and B. Forcade, J. Theodore Meyer and R. Flemal against. An Order denying Respondent's motion to reconsider was then adopted by a vote of 4-2. J. Anderson and J. Theodore Meyer dissented. (BF)

Petitioner's motion to extend time for response was granted with some modification until October 9, 1987 in ##84-45, -61, -68, Waste Management, by a vote of 4-2. J. Anderson and J. Theodore Meyer dissented. (BF)

Agency motions for leave to withdraw prior motions and to amend the Briefing schedule were granted in #85-154, Modine Manufacturing, by a vote of 6-0. (RF)

Petitioner's motion to withdraw was granted in #86-163, Monsanto Company, by a vote of 6-0. (BF)

An Order directing the Agency to file its response to Petitioner's verified motion to modify a May 28, 1987 Board Order by September 30, 1987, was adopted in #86-223, Morton Thiokol, by a vote of 6-0. (JTM)

An application for Stay was denied in #87-34, A.R.F. Landfill, by a vote of 6-0. (JM)

Petitioner's motion for leave to withdraw petition for variance was granted in #87-44, Arlington Park, by a vote of 6-0. (BF)

Petitioner's motion for reconsideration was granted and upon reconsideration motion to dismiss for lack of subject jurisdiction was denied in #87-50, Pike County Sand and Gravel, by a vote of 6-0. (JA)

Petitioner's request for extension of time to file a second amended petition was granted until October 1, 1987 in #87-56, Mt. Vernon Association, by a vote of 6-0. (JD)

Petitioner's motion to withdraw petition was granted in #87-103, City of Crystal Lake, by a vote of 6-0. (BF)

Due to a letter of objection received by the Board a hearing was authorized in #87-131, Amerock Corporation, by a vote of 6-0. (BF)

An Order denying Complainant's least favored and alternative relief request that the site be "sealed" or the Respondent otherwise ordered to cease operations pending a hearing was denied and the Hearing Officer was directed to begin to confer with the parties no later than September 25, 1987 for the purpose of establishing a reasonable, but expedited schedule for discovery and hearing, and to enter an Order setting such dates no later than October 2, 1987, was adopted in #87-132, The City of Chicago, by a vote of 6-0. B. Forcade concurred. (JA)

Dumelle**; 87-113, Illinois Department of Transportation, Frank Heurich and Ralph Falk II, **Chairman authorized to sign the permit document and to prepare an Order**; 87-134, Illinois Department of Transportation, Great Lakes Naval Training Center, **docket opened to allow the Board additional time to review the project**; 87-130, Illinois Department of Transportation, Joseph A. Rosin, **Chairman authorized to sign the**

permit document and to prepare an Order; 87-135, Illinois Department of Transportation, Dr. Richard A. Block, Chairman authorized to sign the permit document and to prepare an Order.


