MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING JANUARY 21, 1988 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

A.M. SESSION

All Board Members were present.

An Order was adopted in #87-17, Citizens Utilities, by a vote of 7-0. (BF)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #AC 87-25, County of Whiteside, by a vote of 7-0. (RF)

An Order requesting the parties to file, by February 2, 1988, a written document discussing whether the complained of activity is an "organized amateur or professional sporting activity", was adopted in #88-16, Hinsdale Golf Club, by a vote of 7-0. (BF)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #87-56, Mt. Vernon Association, by a vote of 7-0. (JA)
