Good afternoon,

PCB mentioned to us that IEPA conducted a study sampling CWS distribution system entry points and finding PFAS in 81 wells that serve 910,000 Illinoisians. Of those 81 wells, we understand that 68 had PFAS levels exceeding the HBGLs. Could you tell us how many people those 68 wells with exceedances serve? If you have the data in a spreadsheet somewhere, we would also be able to parse it ourselves.
