Proposed Rule. Dismissal Order.

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B.F. Currie):

Sections 7.2 and 9.1(e) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (Act) (415 ILCS 5/7.2, 9.1(e) (2022)) require the Board to update the definition of volatile organic material (VOM) with those compounds the USEPA exempts from regulation under state implementation plans for ozone due to negligible photochemical reactivity. USEPA codifies these exemptions as part of its definitions at 40 C.F.R. § 51.100(s).

The Board reserved this docket for USEPA amendments to the definition of VOM made between July 1, 2024 and December 31, 2024. During that time, USEPA took no action that requires Board action. Therefore, the Board dismisses this docket.
