HEARING OFFICER FOX: Good morning, and welcome to this Illinois Pollution Control Board hearing. My name is Tim Fox, and I am the assigned hearing officer for this rulemaking, which is entitled Clean-up Amendments to 35 Illinois Administrative Code Parts 101, 310, 502, 620, 704, 721, 733, 739, 742, 807, 811, 840, 848, 1010, and 1501. The board docket number for this rulemaking is R25-23. The stated purpose of which on the part of IEPA is to update its street address throughout the board's rules where it appears.

To get started I want quickly to go through three preliminary items. Introductions, second the procedure to date, and third the perceived order of the hearing.

First, introductions. Present from the board today here in Chicago are to my right the board's chair Barbara Flynn Currie, who is the lead board member for this docket. And at my left board member Jennifer Van Wie. In addition the board's technical staff, Anand Rao, R-A-O, and Essence Brown are both present. And I can see that in Springfield the board members Michelle Gibson, Michael Mankowski,

and Angela Tin are present, with board attorney advisors Daniel Pauley, P-A-U-L-E-Y, and Anu Paruchuri, P-A-R-U-C-H-U-R-I. I don't think I have overlooked anyone there in Springfield. Have I?

MR. PAULEY: No.

MR. FOX: No. Very good.

Secondly, I want to go through a quick summary of our procedure to date. On March 10th, 2025, IEPA filed its rulemaking proposal, and on March 20th the board accepted the proposal for hearing and submitted it to first notice publication in the Illinois Register without comment on its substantive merits. The board expects that the proposal will appear in the Illinois Register either tomorrow Friday, April -- I'm sorry, Friday, April 18th or the following Friday, April 25th.

Also on March 20th the hearing officer scheduled two hearings, the first of which of course is taking place today, and the second of which will be held on June 5th. The board published notice of both hearings on March 22nd in the Chicago Suntimes, and on March 26th in the State Journal Register of Springfield.

The hearing officer order directed the

participants intending to testify today at this hearing to pre-file testimony and exhibits no later than Thursday, April 10th, but the board did not receive any pre-filed testimony for this hearing.

On March 27th a hearing officer order did request comment on a specific question from IEPA, the board received IEPA's response on April 11th. And I want the record to reflect that we appreciate the prompt and detailed response, which is very helpful in building our record for this proceeding.

Third, our proposed order. We will begin with any person or persons who indicate that they would like to offer public comment, then we can see whether there is anyone who did not pre-file testimony but wishing to testify today.

I do have one question to put into the record for IEPA, and then we can quickly determine whether anyone does wish to offer comments before we adjourn. Is there any question about our procedure? Neither seeing nor hearing any, I do want to remind all that this hearing is governed by the board's procedural rules. All information that is relevant and that is not repetitious or privileged will be admitted into the record.

Please bear in mind also that any questions posed today by the board or its staff intend only to help develop a clear and complete record for the board's decision and do not reflect any judgment or decision on any testimony, comments, questions or responses.

For the sake of our court reporter here in Chicago, I just ask you to please speak as clearly and loudly as you can and avoid speaking at the same time as another person so that we can have a clear record. Any questions before we get under way? Again, neither seeing nor hearing any, I can see that the sign-in sheet in order to offer comment here in Chicago is blank.

Miss Paruchuri, is there anyone in Springfield who appears to offer public comment?

MS. PARUCHURI: There is not.

HEARING OFFICER FOX: Very good. We can see also whether there is anyone who did not pre-file testimony. As I mentioned, we received none pre-filed by the deadline.

Miss Paruchuri, anyone there who appears to wish to offer testimony this morning?

MS. PARUCHURI: There is not.

HEARING OFFICER FOX: There is not. I'm neither seeing nor hearing any here in Chicago either. We can move along very quickly.

As I mentioned, I have one question to put into the record to pose to the agency. The board notes that for the anticipated first notice publication of the proposal in the Illinois Register, the Secretary of State has indicated that in Section 742.210A, which is a lengthy list of incorporations by reference. The web address for some of the U.S. EPA publications no longer linked to the incorporated document, they have spotted this issue at the end of the many incorporations by reference — incorporations by reference in this subsection.

The board as I mentioned does expect first notice publication in the next couple of weeks, and expects also that when it appears it will have updated links to a handful of those incorporated publications. The board also notes that two of those publications do not apparently have updated current or active links, the first of which is test methods in SW-846 through Revision IV, Roman numeral IV B dated 2007, and promulgated test methods 3C and 16 also dated 2007.

Since the first notice of proposal has not yet been published, the board would simply request that IEPA as the proponent in this rulemaking address those incorporations by reference in writing by a later date that we can set off of the record before we adjourn today.

Is there anyone finally who has appeared in the last few moments to offer a public comment?

MS. PARUCHURI: Not in Springfield, no.

HEARING OFFICER FOX: And neither in Chicago I don't see or hear anyone who wishes to. I do want to move quickly to the issue of the economic impact study.

Section 27B of the Environmental Protection
Act provides that the board must request that the
Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity
conduct an economic impact study of proposed rules
before the board adopts them. The board must then
make either the study or the department's explanation
for not conducting it available to the public at
least 20 days before a public hearing.

In a letter dated March 20th, 2025, the board's chair, Barbara Flynn Currie, requested the DCEO conduct a study of that proposal and requested a

Can we go off the record just for a moment to clear up solely procedural questions.

HEARING OFFICER FOX: We may go back on the record very quickly, please. After briefly going off the record to discuss procedural matters, I want to confirm that the second hearing in this proceeding will take place as originally scheduled on Thursday, June 5th, 2025 beginning at 11:15 a.m. with a deadline of Thursday, May 29th, 2025 to pre-file testimony. Copies of the transcript of today's hearing are expected to be available no later than Thursday, May 1st. When the board receives that, it will of course promptly post it to the clerk's office online or COOL on the board's website from which it can be reviewed and printed.

IEPA off the record helpfully agreed to file a written response to the board's question placed
