<p><a href="#"><u>PCB 25-51</u></a></p>	<p><u>People of the State of Illinois v. Gould Transportation Services, Inc. d/b/a Gould Bus Services</u> (Water, NPDES – Enforcement) – In this enforcement action concerning Gould’s school bus transportation and storage businesses located in Tuscola, Douglas County, and Oakland, Coles County, the Board granted relief from the hearing requirement of Section 31(c)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(1) (2022)), accepted a stipulation and proposed settlement, and ordered respondents to pay a \$13,600 civil penalty and to cease and desist from further violations.</p>	<p>5-0 roll call vote</p>
<p><a href="#"><u>PCB 25-54</u></a></p>	<p><u>People of the State of Illinois v. Murphy-Brown LLC d/b/a Smithfield Hog Production</u> (Water, NPDES – Enforcement) – Upon receiving a stipulation and proposal for settlement, along with a corresponding motion for relief from the hearing requirement, the Board directed the Clerk to provide the required newspaper notice in this enforcement action concerning a Wayne County concentrated animal feeding operation.</p>	<p>5-0 roll call vote</p>
<p><a href="#"><u>PCB 25-55</u></a></p>	<p><u>Union Pacific Railroad (Dupo Terminal) v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency</u> (Water, NPDES – Permit Appeal) – The Board directed Union Pacific Railroad to file an amended petition for review remedying the deficiencies specified accompanied by the appearance of an attorney by May 19, 2025.</p>	<p>5-0 roll call vote</p>
