MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME AND CONTINUANCE OF HEARING

NOW COMES the NATIONAL WASTE AND RECYCLING ASSOCIATION ("NWRA"), by and through its attorneys, Brown, Hay + Stephens, LLP, and hereby moves to extend the deadline for submittal of proposals and pre-filed testimony as well as to continue the hearing set in this matter. In support, NWRA states the following:

- 1. In an Opinion and Order entered May 15, 2025, the Board directed participants to provide information regarding landfills regulated under Parts 811 and 814 that would be affected by the addition of Part 620 PFAS groundwater quality standards. (Opinion and Order of May 15, 2025). The Board directed participants to address eight (8) information requests while also providing that any proposals and pre-filed testimony are due on July 14, 2025. *Id.* Finally, the Board directed hearing officers to hold a hearing in Springfield, Illinois, on August 12, 2025. *Id.*
- 2. On May 21, 2025, the Hearing Officer issued an Order providing that all pre-filed testimony is due July 11, 2025. (Hearing Officer Order of May 21, 2025).
- 3. The Board's procedural rules grant the Hearing Officer "authority to rule on all motions that are not dispositive of the proceeding." 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.502(a). Specifically, the Board's rules grant the Hearing Officer the authority to set hearings. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.610. The Hearing Officer may also require the prefiling of testimony, questions, and responses if she determines the procedure will "provide for a more efficient hearing." 35 Ill. Adm. Code 102.424(b).

- 4. While it has begun gathering the information and preparing its responses to the eight (8) information requests set forth in the Board's May 15, 2025, Opinion and Order, NWRA has determined that completing the task will require substantial additional time and effort. In addition, NWRA and Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") staff have agreed to meet on July 8, 2025, in person in Springfield to discuss this rulemaking. NWRA anticipates that this meeting likely will impact the information and responses NWRA tenders in response to the Board's information requests. Accordingly, to provide additional time to incorporate the information obtained from its July 8, 2025, meeting with Illinois EPA staff as well as to complete gathering information and preparing its responses to the Board's information requests in sufficient time in advance of hearing, NWRA seeks a 30-day extension of the deadline for submitting proposals and pre-filed testimony as well as a 30-day continuance of the hearing date in this matter.
- 5. Allowing additional time to prepare and submit proposals and pre-filed testimony will allow for a more efficient and productive hearing.
- 6. On June 10 and 11, 2025, the undersigned counsel for NWRA conferred with counsel for Illinois EPA regarding NWRA's Motion for Extension of Time And Continuance of Hearing. On June 11, 2025, counsel for Illinois EPA stated that the Agency had no objection to NWRA's motion seeking a 30-day extension of the deadline for submitting proposals and pre-filed testimony as well as to a 30-day continuance of the hearing.
- 7. On June 11, 2025, the undersigned counsel for NWRA contacted the Hearing Officers in this proceeding and advised them of NWRA's intention to file this motion for the reasons set forth above, and further advised them that Illinois EPA had no objection to the motion.

WHEREFORE, so that it may fully gather information and prepare complete responses to

the Board's information requests sufficiently in advance of hearing, NWRA moves this honorable

Board to extend by thirty (30) days the deadline for submitting proposals and pre-filed testimony

as well as to continue for thirty (30) days the hearing date presently set in this matter.
