ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M. Gibson):

On July 10, 2025, at the parties' request, the Board extended until October 6, 2025, the time period for BP Products North America, Inc. (BP) to appeal a May 21, 2025 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). The determination concerns BP's former petroleum refinery in Wood River, Madison County. On October 6, 2025, BP timely filed a petition asking the Board to review the Agency's determination. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2024); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206, 105.208.

On October 30, 2025, before the Board accepted its petition, BP filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss its appeal (Mot.). BP reports that it has met with the Agency and resolved the disputed issues. Mot. at 2. BP moves for dismissal "because there are no remaining issues to be decided by the Board." *Id.* BP adds that the Agency "does not object" to the motion.

The Board grants BP's unopposed motion for voluntary dismissal and closes the docket.
