ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. A. Van Wie)

On December 12, 2025, C.J. Goodall Tire Co., Inc. (Goodall) filed a petition under Section 28.1 of the Environmental Protection Act (Act) and Part 104 of the Board's procedural rules. *See* 415 ILCS 5/28.1 (2024); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104. Subpart D. Goodall petitions the Board for an adjusted standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 848. Specifically, Goodall seeks an adjusted standard from the Board's provisions for used and waste tires at its facility located at 905 West Boulevard in Belleville, St. Clair County.

On December 31, 2025, Goodall filed a motion to dismiss the petition (Mot.). Goodall states it would not be able to timely accomplish publication of the notice of filing its petition in a newspaper of general circulation within 14 days of filing its petition with the Board. Mot. at 1; *see* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.408. Goodall moves to dismiss due to its concern that this lack of timely publication will cause the Board to lack jurisdiction over the petition. *Id.* Additionally, Goodall states it intends to refile its petition and does not wish to burden the Board with a duplicative filing. *Id.*

Because Goodall did not submit proof under Section 104.408 that it timely published a notice of filing of the petition in a newspaper of general circulation within 14 days of filing its petition with the Board, the Board grants Goodall's motion to dismiss. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.414; *see* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.408.
