Please accept this letter with attached diagrams, in addition to the previously drafted letter on April 16, 1996 (attached) in reference to PCB# 96-186. As parents our primary concern and responsibility is our children's rights for a healthy living environment. Thus the residents feel it is imperative to consider the alleged noise violations our children are exposed to in their homes from the alleged source. By having anywhere from one to thirty people playing unsupervised only feet from their bedroom windows and playrooms, at very unpredictable times including dinner time, nap time, and school nights, the children are exposed to documented excessive sound levels of moaning, groaning, shoe squeaking, ball bouncing, and the unrelenting and abusive profanity at noise levels that can be clearly heard in their bedrooms even with windows closed. This has greatly effected their sleeping habits including naps with the preschoolers and has a negative effect on their behavior and ability to concentrate in school since most nights they are sleep deprived do to the alleged noise levels in their rooms from the basketball court. We are appealing to you The State Of Illinois Pollution Control Board with jurisdiction to fairly and openly consider the alleged abuses as we consider them crucial to our children's normal development and the well being of the family as a whole.

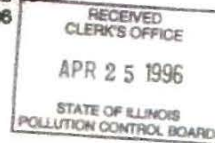




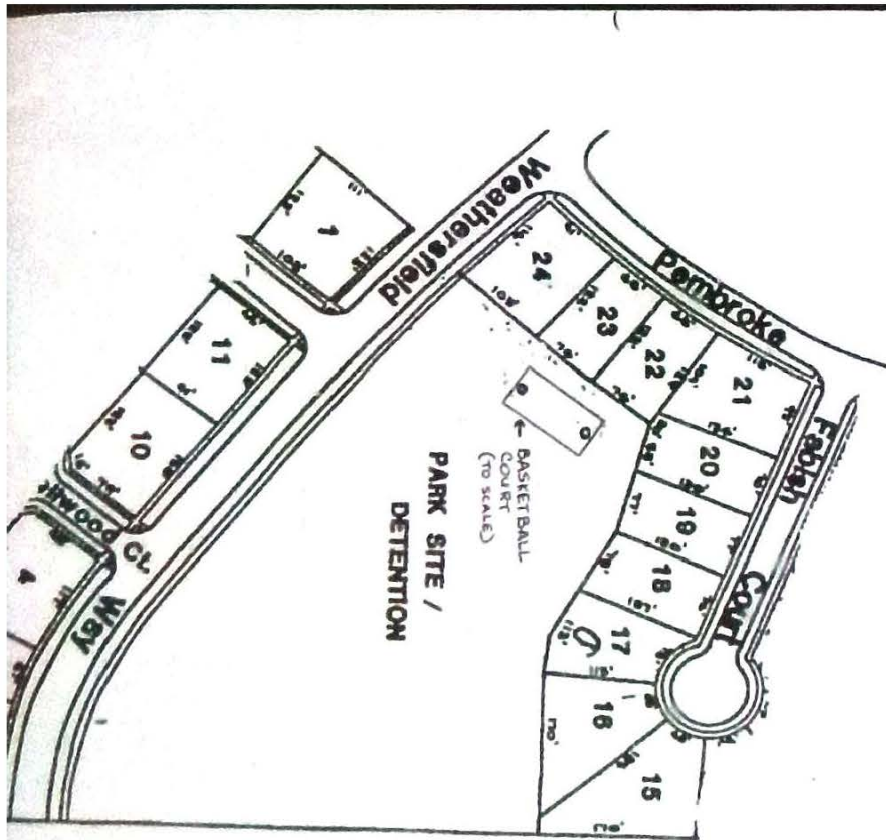
