
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. A. Van Wie):

On March 9, 2026, Waste Management of Illinois, Inc., doing business as CID Recycling & Disposal Facility (CID Recycling), timely filed a petition asking the Board to review an October 27, 2025 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2024); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206. The determination concerns CID Recycling’s hazardous waste disposal facility, specifically two closed hazardous waste management units located at 138th Street and Calumet Expressway, Calumet City, Cook County. Accompanying CID Recycling’s petition for review was a motion to stay the effectiveness of the contested permit conditions.

On March 19, 2026, the Board accepted the petition for hearing but reserved ruling on the motion for stay to allow the Agency’s response time to run. *See* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.500(d). No objection to the motion was filed by the Agency. Accordingly, the Board grants the motion to stay the effectiveness of the contested permit conditions pending the Board’s final action on the petition for review or until the Board orders otherwise.
