
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M. Gibson):

On March 25, 2025, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Premcor Refining Group, Inc. (Premcor) may appeal a February 23, 2026 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2024); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency denied Premcor’s Corrective Measures Completion Report for the Soil Vapor Extraction System plan for its facility in Madison County.

The parties’ request seeks an extension of not more than 125 days from Premcor’s receipt of the Agency’s determination or until “October 27, 2026.” Request at 1. The Board construes the requested “October 27, 2026” date as a scrivener’s error, as that date is well past the latest date to which the Board may extend the appeal period under Section 40(a)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2024)). The Board extends the appeal period until Friday, July 3, 2026, which, as the parties request, is the 125th day after Premcor’s February 28, 2026 receipt of the Agency’s determination. *See id.*; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If Premcor fails to file an appeal on or before July 6, 2026, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
