
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. Dumelle):

On March 14, 1983 the City of Mount Olive filed an amended petition for variance which remains deficient in that the reason for restricted status is lacking (such explanation should include a discussion of when the sewer extension was built and why it was built during the period of restricted status) and although the owner of the six-unit apartment complex at issue here (Macoupin County Housing Authority) has been added to the case caption, there is no proof of service of process upon him pursuant to Section 103.123 of the Procedural Rules.

Unless an amended petition is filed curing the above-noted defects within 45 days of the date of this Order, the petition will be subject to dismissal.
