**RECOMMENDATION OF THE ILLINOIS
ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY**

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") hereby files its Recommendation pursuant to Section 125.204 of the regulations of the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board"), 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

1. On February 23, 2026, the Illinois EPA received a request from Shelden Johnson (Log number TC-153863, Exhibit A) for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.
2. The facility's address is: Shelden Johnson
643 Twp. Rd. 650 East
Carman, Illinois 61425

The proposed water pollution control facilities in this request are located in the SE ¼ of Section 24, T9N, R6W in Henderson County, at the above street address and consist of the following livestock waste management structures:

One (1) concrete manure pit measuring 281.33 ft. (length) x 71.17 ft. (width) x 8 ft. (depth), precast concrete slatted flooring over the manure pit, all concrete columns, and precast beams supporting the floor. The manure deep pit has four (4) pumpout pits measuring 6 ft. (length) x 6 ft. (width) x 8 ft. (depth) to allow manure removal from the pit. The pit has a recessed sump area measuring 2.33 ft (length) x 2.33 ft. (width) x 10 ft. (depth).

These livestock waste management facilities are used to collect, transport and/or store livestock waste prior to cropland application.

3. Section 11-10 of the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2024), and Section 125.200(a) of the Board's regulations, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), define "pollution control facilities" as:

any system, method, construction, device or appliance appurtenant thereto or any portion of any building or equipment, that is designed, constructed, installed or operated for the primary purpose of: eliminating, preventing, or reducing air or water pollution ...or treating, pretreating, modifying or disposing of any potential solid, liquid or gaseous pollutant which if released without treatment, pretreatment modification or disposal might be harmful, detrimental or offensive to human, plant or animal life, or to property.

4. In order to receive preferential tax treatment as pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/11-5 (2024), pollution control facilities must be certified as such by the Board, 35 ILCS 200/11-20 (2024) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a).
5. Upon receipt of a tax certification application, the Illinois EPA must file a recommendation on the application with the Board, 35 Ill Adm. Code 125.204(a).
6. Based on the information in the application and the purpose of the facility, it is the Illinois EPA's engineering judgment that the described facilities may be considered "pollution control facilities," pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200, and are eligible for tax certification from the Board.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA recommends that the Board issue the requested tax certification.

Precast concrete slotted floors enable excreta and wastewater to fall through and accumulate in the below floor pits. The end walls have footings that are 8" thick and 1'-4" wide. The side walls have footings that are 8" thick and 1'-4" wide. The center divider wall has a footing that is 10" thick 1'-8" wide. Columns within the pit are 14" in diameter, 7'-2" tall and supported by 36"x36" square footings. The columns support 8"x10"x12ft long precast concrete floor beams. The floor beams support a 4" thick precast concrete slotted gang slat floor. The barn has 4 pumpout pits. Each pumpout pit is 6'-0" x 6'-0" with 8" thick walls. Footings around the pumpout pit walls measure 18" wide by 18" inches thick. The recessed sump area is 2'-4" x 2'-4" x 10" deep. The pumpouts collect manure and allow manure transfer through a hose to be pumped for field application.

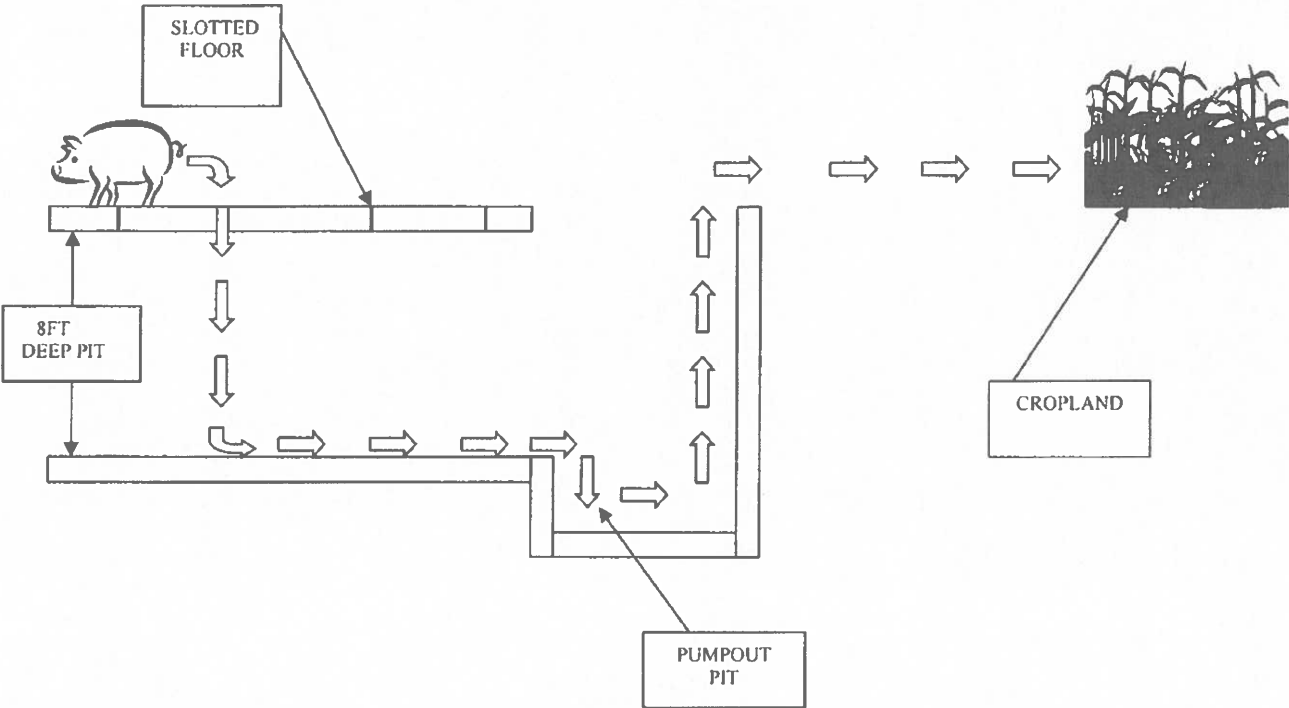
