ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):


On September 16, 1999, pursuant to Section 31.1(b) of the Environmental Protection Act (Act) (415 ILCS 31.1(b) (1998)), the County of Sangamon issued an administrative citation to ESG Watts, Inc., an Iowa corporation. The administrative citation alleges that the respondent violated Sections 21(o)(9), 21(o)(6), and 21(o)(5) of the Act (415 ILCS 5/21(o)(9), 21(o)(6), 21(o)(5) (1998)). The alleged violations occurred at the Sangamon Valley Landfill, 2565 Sand Hill Road, Springfield, Sangamon County, Illinois.

On October 19, 1999, respondent filed a petition for review of the administrative citation pursuant to Section 31.1(d). The Board accepts this matter for hearing. The Board reminds respondent that, after hearing, any person found to have violated the Act as alleged in the administrative citation is liable to pay a penalty under Section 42(b)(4) of the Act of \$500 per violation, as well as any hearing costs incurred by the Board or the complainant. 415 ILCS 42(b)(4) (1998).

The Board directs that this matter proceed to hearing as expeditiously as practicable. The assigned hearing officer must set the matter for hearing in accordance with the requirements of the Act and the Board's procedural rules.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
