ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD September 15, 1976

WINNETKANS INTERESTED IN PROTECTING THE ENVIRONMENT (WIPE), Complainant, PCB 76-215 v. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, Respondent.

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Young):

This matter comes before the Board on a Complaint filed August 27, 1976, by Winnetkans Interested in Protecting the Environment (WIPE). The Environmental Protection Agency filed a Motion to Dismiss on September 14, 1976, and a memorandum suggesting dismissal of the Complaint was filed on the same date by the Village of Winnetka. The Board finds that several of the allegations of the Complaint are duplicitous of the matter now before the Board in WIPE v. The Village of Winnetka (PCB 75-363). The balance of the allegations are so generalized as to be frivolous. The Complaint is dismissed.
