ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On September 18, 2001, the Mecalux Illinois, Inc. (Mecalux) timely filed a petition to extend the 35-day period until November 12, 2001, within which Mecalux may appeal an August 14, 2001 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). Mecalux disputes the Agency's classification of Mecalux as a metal furniture coater. Mecalux's facility is located in Melrose Park, Cook County.

On September 24, 2001, the Agency filed a letter concurring with Mecalux's petition to extend the 35-day appeal period. The Board extends the appeal period until November 12, 2001, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If Mecalux fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
