INTERIM ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Zeitlin):

This matter was filed with the Board as an "Emergency Plea for Variance" on January 10, 1977; action was subsequently deferred by the Board, pending receipt of an Environmental Protection Agency Recommendation. On January 28, 1977, the Agency filed a Motion to Dismiss or Order Additional Information.

The Board finds that significant issues raised in the Agency's Motion are not answered in the Petition. Petitioner shall respond fully to those issues within 30 days of the date of this Order, which response may take the form of an Amended Petition or other appropriate pleading. Failure to so respond may be cause for dismissal of the Petition without prejudice. The 90-day decision period set by statute shall run from the date of filing such Amended Petition.
