INTERIM ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Zeitlin):

On December 2, 1976, this Board entered an Interim Order staying the instant proceedings, pursuant to a Motion filed by Respondent General Motors Corporation on November 18, 1976. That Interim Order granted General Motors 30 days within which to submit an appropriate permit application for the facilities in issue. In a subsequent Motion, filed on December 29, 1976, General Motors has requested a further period of 60 days within which to prepare and file such permit applications.

The latter motion, being directly responsive to discussion by the Board at its December 2, 1976, meeting, is granted. Our Interim Order of December 2, 1976, staying the instant proceedings, shall be extended for an additional 60-day period.
