ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. Dumelle):

On November 19, 1981 the Board entered an order in this proceeding granting variance from Rule 1201 of Chapter 3: Water Pollution, subject to certain conditions. On January 11, 1981 the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) filed a motion to modify that Order pursuant to Procedural Rule 334(a), correctly pointing out that the Board had inadvertently neglected to impose the standard certification condition. That motion is granted and the November 19, 1981 Board Order in this matter is hereby modified by adding the following after condition 3:

4. Within forty-five days of the date of this Order, the City of Peru shall execute and forward to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 2200 Churchill Road, Springfield, Illinois 62706, a Certificate of acceptance and agreement to be bound to all terms and conditions of this variance. This forty-five day period shall be held in abeyance for any period during which this matter is being appealed. The form of the certificate shall be as follows:
