ORDER OF THE BOARD (by I. Goodman):

It is the Order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board that Rule 203(g)(1) of Chapter 2, Air Pollution Control Rules and Regulations, be amended to add the following subsection:

(E) New and Existing Coal-fired Industrial Boilers Equipped with Flue Gas Desulfurization Systems.

Notwithstanding sub-paragraphs (A)-(D) of Rule 203(g)(1), no person shall cause or allow the emission of particulate matter into the atmosphere from new or existing coal-fired industrial boilers equipped with flue gas desulfurization systems to exceed 0.25 pounds of particulate matter per million Btu's of actual heat input in any one-hour period.
