Adopted Rule. Final Order.

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by I. Goodman):

The First and Second Notice Periods following the September 26, 1980 Illinois Register notice of rulemaking having expired, and no public comment or Joint Committee on Administrative Rules objection having been received, the Board hereby orders the Clerk to file the deletion of Rule 205 as ordered on January 8, 1981, and the associated amendment of Rule 209(c), with the Secretary of State.

The Board notes that it issued its Opinion in this matter on July 24, 1980 (covering both this proceeding and the one of R76-14, forging noise), specifically at pages 2-3 and 7.

The repealed Rule 205 had read:

Rule 205: Sound Emitted to Class C Land

Except as elsewhere in this Part 2 provided, no person shall cause or allow the emission of sound from any property line noise source located on any Class A, B or C land to any receiving Class C land which exceeds any allowable octave band sound pressure level specified in Table 4, when measured at any point within such receiving Class C land, provided, however, that no measurement of sound pressure level shall be made less than 25 feet from such property line noise source.

The amended Rule 209(c) now reads:

Rule 209: Compliance Dates For Part 2

- (c) Every owner or operator of an existing property-line-noise-source who emits sound which exceeds any allowable octave band sound pressure level of Rules 202, 203, or 204 ~~or 205~~ by 10 dB or more in any octave band with a center frequency of 31.5 Hertz, 63 Hertz or 125 Hertz shall comply with the standards and limitations of Part 2 of this Chapter on and after eighteen months from the effective date of this Chapter.
