ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Marlin):

This matter is before the Board upon its own motion. A Petition for Review was filed on September 8, 1989 to contest the Administrative Citation filed in this case and a hearing was authorized. Subsequently, the Board allowed the Citation to be amended down to one count with a corresponding reduction in the civil penalty.

Upon review of the record the Board finds that there appears to be no further issues in controversy. Even so, respondent has not filed a motion to dismiss the Petition for Review. If the respondent is not going to contest the remaining count of the Administrative Citation, the Board is required to make a final finding of violation pursuant to Section 31.1 of the Environmental Protection Act in a standard default order. See, In the Matter of: Waste Management of Illinois, Inc., AC 88-53, September 8, 1988.

The Board hereby orders the respondent, Stryker International, to inform the Board of its intent or to file a motion to dismiss Petition for Review with the Board by March 29, 1990. Failure to comply with this order will result in a standard default order being entered against the respondent.
