ORDER OF THE BOARD (by T.E. Johnson):

On December 23, 2002, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Chicago Fire Brick Company (Fire Brick) may appeal a November 13, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000) *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency denied part of Fire Brick's request for reimbursement from the Underground Storage Tank Fund regarding a leaking underground storage tank site at 7531 South Ashland in Chicago, Cook County. The Board extends the appeal period until March 18, 2003, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000) *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Fire Brick fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
