ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Petition filed April 26, 1974 is inadequate in that the Rules and Regulations from which variance is required are not listed. The environmental impact of emissions for which variance is requested is also not given.

Petitioner shall file within 35 days from the date of this order additional information to cover the points specified. Failure to timely file the needed information shall make the petition liable to dismissal for inadequacy. The 90-day decision period set by statute shall run from the date of filing the additional information.
