ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Upon discussion of the instant case, the Board desires additional information within 30 days from the date of this order on the following: the cost of using alternative methods of disposal such as the air curtain destructor or a chipper; the present uses of the 261-acre tract in question (farming, camping, investment, etc.); a map of the tract or tracts showing the exact location of the City of Salem boundary and lastly, the date of ultimate compliance with the Regulation.

The needed information shall be filed with the Board and Agency. The 90-day decision period set by statute shall run from the date of receipt of this information. Failure to timely file the needed information shall make the petition liable to dismissal for inadequacy.
