ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Petition filed March 4 is inadequate in that it does not state whether the sewer connection requested in Butrick Street would drain to or through a sewer rated by the Environmental Protection Agency as insufficient in hydraulic capacity for transport.

Petitioner is ordered to file an amended petition within 45 days to supply the requested information. If the sewer is in fact inadequate in transport capacity then petitioner shall state when it is expected to be made adequate.

Failure to timely file the amended petition will make the instant case liable to dismissal for inadequacy. The 90-day period for decision shall run from the time of filing the amended petition.
