ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Marder)

Petition for Variance in this matter is inadequate in that there is no information relating to alternates to solvent switching that could be used to bring Petitioner's facility into compliance. The Petition further fails in that there is no data on the amount of emissions to the atmosphere. Petitioner fails to discuss the possibility of using a vapor recovery system or water-based paints. Petitioner also has failed to file any definite plan which will bring its facility into compliance with Rule 205 (f).

Petitioner shall file an Amended Petition in this matter within 35 days of the entry of this Order. Such Petition shall contain the information mentioned above.

Failure to timely file such Amended Petition shall result in the dismissal of this action for inadequacy.
