INTERIM ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle)

The petition filed July 1, 1973 with the Agency and July 16, 1973 with the Board is inadequate because it does not discuss the alternative of construction of a new septic system. Cost estimates for this alternative, the actual area and terrain of the lot, and the suitability of the land for a seepage field should be provided to the Board within 30 days.

Petitioner should also file a waiver of the 90-day decision period for the time which elapses until the additional information is filed.

Failure to file within the 30 day period shall make the petition liable to dismissal for inadequacy.
