ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

The Pollution Control Board, hereby orders the City of Breese and the Environmental Protection Agency, to submit the following information by March 31, 1974 in order to allow the Board to make a determination concerning this Petition for Variance:

1. The current status of the December 12, 1973 contract offer to the City of Breese by Illinois Power Company;
2. An accounting for the apparent discrepancy 24,131 Btu per kilowatt hour figure on page 7 of the transcript and the 1.2 mill per kilowatt figure on page 67;
3. An explanation of the impact of the Federal Energy Office recommendation that no existing power plant convert from coal to oil burning, on the Variance Petition.
