ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle)

This petition, received January 18, 1973, asks for permission to connect a home at 3224 Cornell in Waukegan to a city sewer. The Board sewer ban in Waukegan applies only to certain overloaded and inadequate sewers. Nothing in the petition tells whether the sewer in question is overloaded or adequate.

If the sewer is not overloaded then the Petitioner does not need a variance. Petitioner shall provide to the Board by or before February 8, 1973 information as to whether or not the sewer to be used is categorized as overloaded by the Agency. The 90-day period for variances shall run from the date of submission of the additional information herein requested.
