INTERIM ORDER OF THF BOARD (by Mr. Goodman):

Since there is no Board procedure for renewal or extension of variances the Board considers all such petitions for renewals as a new petition for variance. The Board has therefore numbered Petitioner's request PCB 75-355 and hereby requests that Petitioner amend its petition of September 9, 1975, by incorporating the record in PCB 74-444 and, due to the requirements of a recent Supreme Court decision (Train v. NRDC, 43 USLW 4467), the Board will require Petitioner to show that his emission will not violate or cause violation of Primary Ambient Air Quality Standards.

Petitioner shall amend the petition as required above within 45 days of the date of this Order. Failure to timely file the amended petition with the Board and the Environmental Protection Agency shall render the petition herein liable to dismissal for inadequacy.
