Lt. Colonel Willis S. Rosing as Commanding Officer, Joliet Army Ammunition Plant; Brigadier-General Laurence E. Van Buskirk, as Commanding Officer, United States Army Ammunition Procurement and Supply Agency; Mr. James R. Schlesinger, as Acting Secretary of Defense; and the United States of America,

and that line 2 of paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 of the complaint be amended to read as follows: "continuing each day thereafter to the date of this Complaint, December 1, 1972": and that paragraph 6 of the complaint be deleted.

Oral argument was held before the Board on the basic jurisdiction of the Board to hear and decide the complaint at which time counsel for the U. S. Government and Uniroyal stated on the record that they did not oppose the motion for leave to amend filed herein.

The motion for leave to amend is granted. Complainant shall file an amended complaint reflecting the amendments as allowed and make service upon all parties designated as parties Respondent. Uniroyal, Inc. is dismissed as a party Respondent, not being so designated in the proceeding pursuant to the amendments herein allowed.
