ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Petition filed September 9 is inadequate in that it does not give the effects of the Wheaton Sanitary District sewage treatment plant effluent upon the receiving stream nor does it give the strength of that effluent. Also the phrase "substitute facilities" to be used in the alternative is not adequately described.

An amended petition shall be filed with the Board and Agency within 35 days from the date of this Order. The 90-day decision period set by statute shall run from the date of filing the additional information. Failure to timely file the needed information shall make the petition liable to dismissal for inadequacy.
