ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Motion to Reconsider Dismissal filed by the Agency July 22 alleges that petitioner "does need" a variance as determined from computations made from certain data. The petitioner, however, has not also requested reconsideration and its petition still stands before this Board showing emissions wholly within the rules and regulations.

We think it best to deny this motion leaving the burden, as it properly belongs, upon the petitioner, to examine its own situation and to understand the rules and regulations.

The motion is denied.
