Code Part 309 NPDES Permits and Permitting Procedures</u> – The Board granted the Illinois Environmental Regulatory Group’s motion for leave to file a reply and the Illinois Association of Wastewater Agencies’ motion for leave to file a response and reply instanter. The Board denied the motion for a third hearing and directed the hearing officer to issue an order specifying the deadline for closing the pre-first notice comment period. If the Board proceeds to first notice, at least one additional hearing will be held prior to moving to second notice with the proposed rule.	6-1 Johnson dissented R, Water

Steve Koester (Champaign/ S&amp;K Fence Company)</u> – In response to a joint stipulation and settlement agreement in this administrative citation action involving a Champaign County facility, the Board found respondent violated Section 21(p)(3) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3) (2002)) and ordered respondents to pay a civil penalty of \$1,500. The Board also granted the parties’ joint motions to name S&K Fence Company as the sole respondent, to dismiss the alleged violation of Section 21(p)(1) and (p)(7) of the Act. 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1), (p)(7) (2002), and to dismiss respondent’ petition for review.	7-0
