Facts

For this Administrative Citation to **Marvin J. Wilson**, the City of Chicago Department of Environment ("CDOE") states as follows:

- 1. Complainant, CDOE, is a unit of local government to which the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has delegated authority to issue administrative citations pursuant to Section 4(r) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act ("Act"), 415 ILCS 5/4(r) (2003). CDOE is thus a "delegated unit" and may issue administrative citations under 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.200.
- 2. Respondent, Marvin J. Wilson is an Illinois resident who was the president and registered agent of Ramp Services Inc., a dissolved Illinois Corporation that is the titled owner of real property located at 611 West 51st Street, Chicago, Illinois.
- 3. On July 29, 2003, CDOE inspector Benjamin Nwigwe inspected Respondent's property. A copy of his inspection report is attached as Exhibit 1 and made a part of this Administrative Citation.

- 4. Based upon direct observations made by Mr. Nwigwe during the course of his inspection, CDOE has determined that Respondent violated the Act as follows:
 - a. Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, in violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2003).
 - b. Respondent caused or allowed the open burning of refuse dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, in violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3) (2003).
 - c. Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general and/or clean construction or demolition debris, in violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2003).
- 5. Mr. Nwigwe's affidavit, attesting to his material actions and observations, is attached as Exhibit 2 and made a part of this Administrative Citation.
- 6. Based upon the foregoing facts, under Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2003), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total civil penalty of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00).

Notices and Instructions to Respondent

- 1. You must pay the civil penalty set forth above unless you contest this Administrative Citation. The following paragraphs contain payment instructions and more information about contesting this Administrative Citation.
- 2. To pay the civil penalty (and any other amounts due) send a check or money order, payable to the City of Chicago, to:

To ensure that you receive timely and proper credit for your payment, complete a Remittance Form (see Exhibit 3, attached) and include it with your payment.

- 3. You may contest this Administrative Citation by filing a Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Appearance, with the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board").
 - 4. Any Petition for Review must be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date

of service of this Administrative Citation on you. The Board will not review the Administrative Citation if the Petition for Review is not filed within this time.

.5. The Petition for Review must be filed with:

6. The contents of a Petition for Review and the procedures to be followed are governed by the Board's procedural rules. Copies may be obtained from the Clerk of the Board at the address above, by calling the Board at (312) 814-3620, or from the Board's web site at:

- 7. If you do not contest this Administrative Citation by filing a petition for review with the Board within the allotted time, the Board will enter an order finding that you committed the violations alleged above and imposing the statutory civil penalty set forth above. See Section 31.1(d) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d) (2003), and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.500(a).
- 8. If you contest this Administrative Citation by filing a timely petition for review with the Board, the Board will hold a hearing. The Board's procedural rules have more information on hearings; see 35 Ill. Adm. Code Parts 101 and 108.
- 9. If the Board finds after the hearing that you committed a violation as alleged above, you will be assessed the hearing costs incurred by CDOE and the Board. Hearing costs are assessed in addition to the statutory civil penalty for the violations. If the Board finds after the hearing that you did not commit a violation as alleged above, or that the violation resulted from uncontrollable circumstances, you will not be assessed hearing costs and you will not have to pay a civil penalty.

- 10. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time set by the Board in its final order, interest on the amount due will be assessed against you from the date payment is due and including the date that payment is received.
- 11. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time set by the Board in its final order, the Office of the Illinois Attorney General and/or the City of Chicago Department of Law may initiate court proceedings against you to collect the amount due, plus any interest accrued. In that event you may also be liable for court costs.


An inspection of this address was conducted as part of a follow up for a 05-13-03 open fire, and illegal dumping complaint. Upon arrival I patrolled the general area, and assessed the site condition which remained unchanged since the previous visit.

The facility was cluttered with hundreds of wooden pallets in which 65% were accumulated in the workshop, and the rest were found stacked out side at different locations, and in trailers. The facility appeared abandoned and unprotected, and is easily accessible to the public from all angles.

I observed dumped discarded tires, auto parts, trucks, cars, and other debris coupled with several thousands of pallets. Also a small amount of ashes in (photo #1 and photo #2) is most likely from open burning. The prior report also has additional photos of ashes.

Site was referred to the Chicago Fire Department (South Area) for the fire hazard. Lt. Thomas, and Lt. Simmons were contacted on July 22 -2003 at 3:10PM. (747-7555).

The above site was referred to us by Department of Street and Sanitation concerning DOE violations. Upon arrival I observed cinder and ash left over from burnt material on the ground, some of the unburnt pieces of wood I examined looked the same as the stuck pilled pallets in photo #1.

There were accumulation of discarded or junk material on the ground including but not limited to junk car, truck, tires, wood, plastics, drums, garbage truck, dumpster, auto parts, and other equipments.

About 20 cubic yards of construction and demolition material and other debris were dumped on the ground.

No site representative was present at the time of inspection. A title search which indicated Mr. Gregory Paul Smith of 15945 Marsfield St. Harvey IL. 60609 as the respondent was obtained.
