ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Goodman):

Unless Petitioner submits by May 2, 1980, a revised petition for variance which includes facts regarding the following specific provisions of Procedural Rule 401, the proceeding will be dismissed.

- 1. A clear and unconditional waiver of hearing or, alternatively, averred-to facts sufficient to enable the Board to rule on the petition. Rule 401(b).
- 2. A detailed description of proposed equipment and the proposed methods of control to be undertaken to achieve full compliance with Rule 304(c)(1)(B) of Chapter 6, including a time schedule for implementation of full compliance. Rule 401(a)(6).
- 3. A statement of the measures to be undertaken during the period of the variance to minimize the impact of the discharge of contaminants. Rule 401(a)(10).
- 4. A concise factual statement of the reasons that compliance with Rule 304(c)(1)(B) of Chapter 6 would impose an arbitrary or unreasonable hardship upon Petitioner. Rule 401(c).
