ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On June 6, 1995, General Motors Corporation (General Motors) filed a notice of extension of the 35-day appeal period pursuant to Section 40 of the Act, relating to a May 3, 1995 Agency determination regarding General Motors supplemental permit application. On June 7, 1995, the Agency filed its agreement to the extension.

By order of June 8, 1995, the Board reserved Docket PCB 95-164 for any appeal which might be filed by the General Motors. The order stated "In the event that the General Motors fails to file an appeal on or before September 5, 1995 (the 125th day after May 3, 1995), the Board will dismiss the docket as unnecessary."

No appeal has been filed. The docket is accordingly dismissed as unnecessary.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
