MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

NOW COMES the Respondent, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), by one of its attorneys, John J. Kim, Assistant Counsel and Special Assistant Attorney General, and, pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.500, 101.522, and 106.306, hereby requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") waive the normal filing requirements of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 106.306 and grant the Illinois EPA an extension of time within which to file a response to the Petition filed by the Petitioner. In support of this motion, the Illinois EPA states as follows:

- 1. The Petitioner, McLean County School District No. 5, filed its Petition on October 17, 2003. Pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 106.306, the Illinois EPA may file a response to the Petition within twenty-one (21) days after the filing of the Petition. Accordingly, the response, if filed, is due to be filed on or before November 7, 2003.
- 2. Following the filing of the Petition, the Petitioner and the Illinois EPA have been in discussions regarding the merits of the requested relief. The parties believe it may be possible that an understanding can be reached that would obviate the need for this matter to proceed further. However, a short amount of time is still needed to conclude those discussions.

- 3. In the interest of hopefully economizing the expenditure of the parties' and the Board's resources, the Illinois EPA seeks a one week extension of time by which to file its response, if it so chooses.
- 4. The Petitioner will not be prejudiced if this extension is granted since it is an active participant in the afore-mentioned discussions and is interested in reaching an amicable resolution if possible.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, the Illinois EPA hereby respectfully requests that the Board grant the Illinois EPA a one week extension of time to file the a response to the Petition in this matter.
