ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On November 27, 1995, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) and Hickman, Williams & Company of Kentucky (Hickman) filed a notice of extension of the 35-day appeal period pursuant to Section 40 of the Environmental Protection Act (Act), relating to an October 18, 1995 Agency determination regarding Hickman's permit application.

By order of December 7, 1995, the Board reserved Docket PCB 96-109 for any petition which might be filed by Hickman. The order stated, "In the event that Hickman fails to file an appeal on or before January 16, 1996 (the 90th day after October 18, 1995), the Board will dismiss the docket as unnecessary."

No petition has been filed. This matter is dismissed and the docket is closed as unnecessary.
