

ORDER

Having found W.O.W. Truck Lines, Inc. (W.O.W.), in violation of Section 21(g) of the Environmental Protection Act (Act), (415 ILCS 5/21(g)), and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 809.201 in our December 20, 1995 interim opinion and order, we order W.O.W. to do the following:

- 1) W.O.W. shall immediately cease and desist from further violations of the Act or Board regulations.
- 2) W.O.W. shall pay a penalty of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) within 30 days of the date of this order. Such payment shall be made by certified check or money order payable to the Treasurer of the State of Illinois, designated to the Environmental Protection Trust Fund, and shall be sent by First Class mail to:

The certified check or money order shall clearly indicate on its face, the respondent's Federal Employer Identification Number or Social Security Number and that payment is directed to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund.

Any such penalty not paid within the time prescribed shall incur interest at the rate set forth in subsection (a) of Section 1003 of the Illinois Income Tax Act (35 ILCS 5/1003) as now or hereafter amended, from the date payment is due until the date payment is received. Interest shall not accrue during the pendency of an appeal during which payment of the penalty has been stayed.

- 3) W.O.W. shall pay the attorneys fees of eight hundred forty dollars (\$840.00), incurred at a rate of \$120/hour, incurred by the Office of the Illinois Attorney General in its representation of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. Such payment shall be made by certified check or money order payable to the Treasurer of the State of Illinois, designated to the Hazardous Waste Fund, and shall be sent by First Class mail to:


