ORDER OF THE BOARD (by N.J. Melas):


The Board issued a final opinion and order in this matter on July 24, 2003. On August 28, 2003, LTD Commodities (LTD) filed motions for reconsideration, modification, and stay. In a Board order dated September 4, 2003, the Board indicated the final opinion and order in this matter is stayed until the final disposition of LTD's motion for reconsideration.

On September 23, 2003, Steven P. Kaiser, attorney for Anthony and Karen Roti, Paul Rosenstock, and Leslie Weber (complainants), filed a motion for leave to withdraw as counsel. To date, LTD has not responded to the motion. Mr. Kaiser has satisfied the requirements of Section 101.400(b) of the Board procedural rules to withdraw from representation of a party. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.400(b) (2002).

The Board grants Mr. Kaiser leave to withdraw. The Board notes that the complainants must either retain a licensed attorney or represent themselves individually if they wish to further participate in this proceeding. See 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.400.
